




Recipe For Studying God's Word









The ten commandments, Thou shalt, and Thou shalt not, are ten promises, assured to us if we render obedience to the law governing the universe. "If ye love me, keep my commandments." Here is the sum and substance of the law of God. The terms of salvation for every son and daughter of Adam are here outlined (Manuscript 41, 1896).

The Lord has given His holy commandments to be a wall of protection around His created beings, and those who will keep themselves from the defilement of appetite and passion may become partakers of the divine nature.

The first four are pertaining to man's relationship to God



and the last six are pertaining to man's relationship with each other. (John 14:15 & 21; John 15:14)

The precepts of the Decalogue are adapted to all mankind, and they were given for the instruction and government of all. Ten precepts, brief, comprehensive, and authoritative, cover the duty of man to God and to his fellowman; and all [are] based upon the great fundamental principle of love. {1MCP 248}

1st

This command promises to protect us from "false god worship/Idolatry" in our minds. God vows to be our God as long as we are obedient to His commands, statues, and judgments.

2nd

This command promises to protect us from "false god worship/Idolatry" outwardly. God vows to be our God as long as we are obedient to His commands, statues, and judgments.

3rd

This command promises to protect us from misrepresenting Christ with our words.

4th

This command promises to protect us from the "mark of the beast." It is a sign (or seal) between God and His worshippers.



The first four are pertaining to man's relationship to God

5th

This command promises to protect the children if they honor and respect their elders as God's representatives. It a promise with a promise.

Kth

This command promises to teach us how to not harm our brethren physically as well as how to not harm our brethren's spiritual soul, which is their character.





The last six are pertaining to man's relationship with each other.

7th Commandment Thou shalt not commit adultery. Ex. 20:14




This commandment forbids not only <u>acts of impurity</u>, but sensual thoughts and desires, or any practice that tends to excite them. God's law demands purity not only in the outward life but in the secret intents and emotions of the heart.

Christ, who taught the far-reaching obligation of the law of God, declared that the evil thought or look is as truly sin as is the unlawful deed. {Beginning of the End, p. 149}

"Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not commit adultery: but I (Jesus) say unto you, That whosoever *looketh* on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.... It hath been said, Whosoever shall put away his wife, let him give her a writing of divorcement: but I say unto you, That whosoever shall put away his wife, saving for the cause of fornication, causeth her to commit adultery: and whosoever shall marry her that is divorced committeth adultery" (Matthew 5:27-32). {Testimonies on Sexual Behavior, Adultery, and Divorce 201}




Jesus Corrected Misconceptions of Marriage



Among the Jews a man was permitted to put away his wife for the most trivial offenses, and the woman was then at liberty to marry again. This practice led to great wretchedness and sin. In the Sermon on the Mount Jesus declared plainly that there could be no dissolution of the marriage tie except for unfaithfulness to the marriage vow. "Every one," He said, "that putteth away his wife, saving for the cause of fornication, maketh her an adulteress: and whosoever shall marry her when she is put away committeth adultery." AH 340.3

When the Pharisees afterward questioned Him concerning the lawfulness of divorce, Jesus pointed His hearers back to the marriage institution as ordained at creation. "Because of the hardness of your hearts," He said, Moses "suffered you to put away your wives: but from the beginning it was not so." He referred them to the blessed days of Eden when God pronounced all things "very good." Then marriage and the Sabbath had their origin, twin institutions for the glory of God in the benefit of humanity. Then, as the Creator joined the hands of the holy pair in wedlock, saying, A man shall "leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one," He enunciated the law of marriage for all the children of Adam to the close of time. That which the eternal Father Himself had pronounced good was the law of highest blessing and development for man. AH 340.4





Jesus came to our world to rectify mistakes and to restore the moral image of God in man. Wrong sentiments in regard to marriage had found a place in the minds of the teachers of Israel. They were making of none effect the sacred institution of marriage. Man was becoming so hardhearted that he would for the most trivial excuse separate from his wife, or, if he chose, he would separate her from the children and send her away. This was considered a great disgrace and was often accompanied by the most acute suffering on the part of the discarded one. AH 341.1


Christ came to correct these evils, and His first miracle was wrought on the occasion of the marriage. Thus He announced to the world that marriage when kept pure and undefiled is a sacred institution. AH 341.2

A woman may be legally divorced from her husband by the laws of the land and yet not divorced in the sight of God and according to the higher law. There is only one sin, which is adultery, which can place the husband or wife in a position where they can be free from the marriage vow in the sight of God. Although the laws of the land may grant a divorce, yet they are husband and wife still in the Bible light, according to the laws of God. AH 344.2

- Almost 50 percent of all marriages in the United States will end in divorce or separation.
- Researchers estimate that 41 percent of all first marriages end in divorce.
- 60 percent of second marriages end in divorce.
- 73 percent of all third marriages end in divorce.
- The United States has the 6th highest divorce rate in the world
- Every 13 seconds, there is one divorce in America.
- That equates to 277 divorces per hour, 6,646 divorces per day, 46,523 divorces per week, and 2,419,196 divorces per year.
- There are 9 divorces in the time it takes for a couple to recite their wedding vows (2 minutes).
- More than 554 divorces occur during your typical romantic comedy movie (2 hours).
- 1,385 divorces happen during the average wedding reception (5 hours).
- There are 19,353,568 divorces over the course of an average first marriage that ends in divorce (8 years).
- Over a 40 year period, 67 percent of first marriages terminate.
- Among all Americans 18 years of age or older, whether they have been married or not, 25 percent have gone through a marital split.
- 15 percent of adult women in the United States are divorced or separated today, compared with less than one percent in 1920.
- The <u>average first marriage</u> that ends in divorce lasts about 8 years.



The listening people expect Jesus to severely denounce this class, but are surprised when he declares: "Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not commit adultery. But I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart." Those who have looked upon the guilty characters who lead lives of sensual dissipation as sinners above all others, are astonished to hear Jesus assert that those who cherish lascivious thoughts are as guilty at heart as the shameless violators of the seventh commandment.


Jesus condemned the custom then existing of a man putting away his wife for trivial offenses. This practice led to great wretchedness and crime. Jesus strikes at the primary cause of the laxness with which the marriage relation was held, when he condemns the unholy passions which find the marriage institution a barrier to the gratification of their lust. Christ would have the marriage relation hedged about with judicial restrictions, so that there could be no legal separation between husband and wife, save for the cause of adultery. {2SP 221}

The Case Which Contains His Jewels—


The church of Christ is very precious in His sight. It is *the case* which contains His jewels, the fold which encloses His flock. 6BC 1118.9








The word of God plainly presents before us this truth, that our physical natures will be brought into warfare with the spiritual.
